## Information about RoHS and the REACH candidate list

First of all, we should like to point out that there are no substances contained in our range of products mentioned in the RoHS directive and REACH candidate list, which are subject to the communication obligation.

**RoHS III (2015/863/EU)** is an amendment to the first RoHS directive (Directive 2011/65/EU of 8<sup>th</sup> June 2011). The directive restricts the use of hazardous substances in electronic products.

The products of Electro-Isola A/S observe the limit values of 0,1% and 0,01% for the concerned substances mentioned in the RoHS directive.

**The REACH candidate list** is a list of substances, which later may be accepted in the authorisation regulation (Annex XIV), which means that companies using these substances have to apply for authorisation to use them. In the candidate list only SVHC substances (Substances of Very High Concern) are entered.

Elektro-Isola A/S is regularly checking whether a substance has been entered in the candidate list and the authorisation regulation according to REACH Regulation 1907/2006.

Furthermore, Elektro-Isola A/S is regularly checking that we meet our obligations as far as communication is concerned according to REACH article 33.

Article 33 stipulates that each individual supplier of an article containing one or more substances from the candidate list in concentrations of more than 0.1% w/w is to furnish the receiver of the article with information sufficient for the article to be used in a safe manner.

## How is Elektro-Isola A/S doing the checking in practice – and how do we inform your company?

- 1: Every time ECHA is publishing a new candidate list Elektro-Isola A/S is checking in co-operation with our environmental advisor ALTox a/s whether a substance from the candidate list is contained in our products. - 2: If a substance from the candidate list constitutes more than 0.1% w/w, it will appear from article 3 of our safety data sheets, which are available from our web-site: <u>http://www.elektro-isola.com/</u>





- 3: As mentioned above so far there are no substances mentioned in the candidate list contained in our range of products which are subject to the communication obligation.
- 4: If in future a substance is used in our products, which is included in the authorisation regulation, we will try to substitute it by a substance not subject to authorisation. Can the substance contrary to expectations not be substituted, we will apply for authorisation
