POPs substances are defined as:

"Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are organic substances that persist in the environment, accumulate in living organisms and pose a risk to our health and the environment.

They can be transported by air, water or migratory species across international borders, reaching regions where they have never been produced or used.

International risk management is necessary as no region can manage the risks posed by these substances alone." (<https://echa.europa.eu/understanding-pops>)
