

EUDR Compliance Declaration

To whom it may concern,

Elektro-Isola A/S hereby confirms that we are aware of and committed to complying with the provisions of the EU Regulation on deforestation-free products (Regulation (EU) 2023/1115 – EUDR), which comes into force on 30 December 2025 for large companies.

We have implemented internal procedures to ensure that all relevant products and raw materials that we place on the EU market or export from the EU are:

- **Deforestation-free**, i.e., not associated with deforestation or forest degradation after the established cut-off date.
- **Legally produced**, in accordance with applicable legislation in the country of production, including environmental protection, labor rights, and land rights.
- **Traceable**, with documentation of origin and geolocation, where relevant.

We are actively working with our suppliers and partners to collect and verify the necessary information, including geolocation data and risk assessments, as required in Articles 9–11 of the EUDR.

If there are changes to the EUDR's scope, definitions, or due diligence obligations, we will continuously assess whether our declaration needs to be updated, and if so, provide a revised declaration without delay.
